

8th Grade

- Choose a Diploma Plan: Legacy Standard or Legacy Honors.

9th/10th Grade

- Monitor GPA and high school requirements.
- Keep a list of awards, honors, and extracurricular activities for scholarship and college applications.
- Attend College Nights.
- Take the PSAT your 9th and 10th grade years.

11th/12th Grade

- Continue with 9th/10th Grade list.
- Research scholarships and begin to apply.
